C14 Election of Town Mayor

The existing Mayor Cllr Andre was nominated by Cllr McClatchy; the nomination was seconded by Cllr Hanlon. There being no other nominations, Cllr Andre was elected to serve as Mayor for 2014/15.

C14 Address by Outgoing Mayor

/002 Cllr Andre made the following remarks:

"The year completed today has been particularly busy and correspondingly significant. The departure of a Town Clerk who had become such a prominent member of our community presented a significant challenge. Bob Whittome has stepped into the breach, keeping us on track and preparing us to ensure that we introduce our new Town Clerk, in a measured and organised manner. We are most fortunate to have experienced a stream of professional and sensitive Clerks – we have come to regard Bob as a close ally to us all."

C14 Mayor's Allowance

/006 The Deputy Mayor took the Chair for this item.

Council resolved to approve payment of the Mayor's Allowance in the sum of £2,500, in accord with Section 15(5) of the Local Government Act 1972.

C14 Outside Representatives

Council resolved to appoint Cllrs Andre and Goody to represent the Town Council on the One Haverhill Board. Council further resolved to delegate authority to Committees to make other appointments to outside bodies as appropriate.

C14 <u>Town Council Committees</u>

Consideration was given to the composition of Council's committees and Council resolved that the composition of Committees should remain unaltered for 2014/15, but with the following caveat. Cllr Robbins requested consideration be given to including Cllr Firman on the Leisure and Community Committee. Council resolved to delegate authority to the Leisure and Community Committee to consider its composition and determine whether it would be advantageous to create an additional seat for Cllr Firman.
