

Polished Brass	£300.00	Fundraising Concert to help young people in musical education	A report along with a copy of newspaper cuttings and a programme which includes clear credit to the Town Council. The event added £1000 to the fund for education, so a 3:1 leverage from our grant to the direct benefit, plus a successful concert
Reach	£5000	Annual funding from Town Council	Reach sends us regular reports on their work. We have received a newsletter and letter. What is particularly interesting is the active work Reach do to address underlying issues so that people don't need to continue to rely on a food bank. This has led to a very significant reduction in the number of people relying on the food bank, bucking the national trend and attracting the attention of the Trussell Trust to see how Reach are working.
