5a To approve funding the upgrading of the fire detection system at the Haverhill Arts Centre at a cost of £13,363:

Fire Alarm-Equipment Schedule

- 1 x Advanced MX 4202 2loop fire panel with 20 zone led indication.
- 2 x 12v 20ah batteries
- 18 x Apollo xp95 detector base
- 58 x Apollo xp95 optical detectors
- 2 x Apollo xp95 heat detector
- 12 x Apollo xp95 call points
- 34 x Apollo xp95 loop powered sounder base
- 4 x Wall mounted sounder beacon
- 2 x Apollo input /output unit
- 1 x Red lockable fused spur
- 1 lot of cabling, trunking, installation & commissioning.

This system provides specific information on the alarm panel as to which detection point has been triggered. This will make verification quicker and enable us to know immediately which exit route provides a safe evacuation of the building. This would be funded by the Town Council granting funds from maintenance reserves to the Community Trust.

5b To approve the upgrading of the CCTV and alarm system at the Leiston Road Community Centre at a cost of £8,000

The current system does not provide a full level of cover adequate for the building. This would be funded by the Town Council granting funds from maintenance reserves to the Community Trust.

The above two works would reduce maintenance reserves from £130k to £109k. The reserve is held for this type of project.

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
