We have ordered the bins to be provided by West Suffolk.

Clark and Kent addressed drainage issues in March

We have commissioned the contractor to tarmac around the entrance to the track.

In Mid-March, Puddlebrook Nursery hosted a hedge-planting day to plant a native-species hedge connecting the hedge along Greenfields Way to the spinney, to create a wildlife corridor alongside the fence on the surgery end of the BMX track. The children and parents planted a large number of whips.
