

	<p>Care.</p> <p>Despite the difficult economic situation, cinema attendances had fallen by only 0.5 people per screening on average, and income had risen slightly. A decision will be required on the purchase of a digital projector, preferably at the next meeting.</p> <p>Future events include the pensioners' bus trips, which are over-subscribed with an extra coach now needed. Programme of summer events and cinema screenings were circulated.</p> <p>The Jubilee brochure is due for publication in the first week of May, with events including the 'J-Factor', a schools concert, the Big Lunch, a screening of the Jubilee Regatta, and a Beacon Service with lighting of a beacon. Other bodies are organizing events such as the Jubilee Plaza ceremony (Borough Council) and Jubilee Picnic (CATRA).</p> <p>The Festival is coming together well.</p> <p>Although activities around the Torch Visit are being led by the Borough Council, the Town Council is contributing with a street festival, expertise, and a civic platform outside the Arts Centre which will also be available to people with disabilities.</p> <p>A further report on Summer in Haverhill will be presented at the next meeting.</p> <p>Cllr Byrne paid tribute to the Centre Stage pantomime, likening it to those seen in the West End. Cllr Stroud read a letter published in the Cambridge News which favoured the entertainment, facilities and prices at the Arts Centre over those offered at the Cambridge Corn Exchange.
