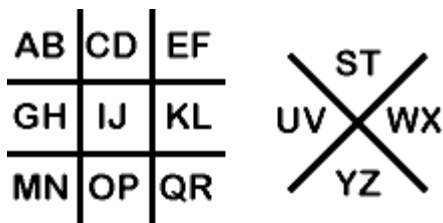




Pigpen



The **Pigpen code** (also sometimes called the Freemason or Rosicrucian cipher) is quite easy to catch on to. First you write out the whole alphabet in two grids, as shown:



Each letter is represented by the part of the "pigpen" that surrounds it.

If it's the second letter in the box, then it has a dot in the middle.

So an A looks like this:

And a B looks like this:

Example:



This is decoded as "LISTEN TO THE WIND".

Use this code to write a message. Give it to a friend to decode.
