Councillor Hanlon welcomed Paul Smith, Lee Barrett and Justin Kinsey to the working party and asked PS to give a brief outline on the application, as the previous presentation had been taken in closed session.

PS explained to members how Euroapi had been formed, the move from Genzyme to Sanofi and then the launch of Euroapi in 2022, which is the UK division within a parent company. Euroapi UK are a new small, independent pharmaceutical company.

PS explained that the reason behind the application was to install solar panels on land which had been purchased 12 years ago and had remained vacant other than a storage warehouse, which would remain.

JK explained that due to high energy costs combined with other challenges, Euroapi had started to look at budgets last year. They received grant funding from Central Euroapi towards a solar farm which would then help towards significantly reducing the impact of the high energy costs.

Following the further information received, Councillor Brown proposed that the Town Council rescind their objection and support the application. Councillor Luccarini, seconded.
