Debate took place around the advantages and disadvantages of a gated, lockable area which requires an app to book appointments for use.

Concerns were raised over the need of an app-based booking system which could potentially deter casual players who might want to turn up on a whim, the current set up also allows football and basketball to be played at the same time. The advantage of the proposed bookable pitches ensures guaranteed playtime, booking ahead ensures players would not have to compete for space, share the court with others or be forced to vacate if others arrive. A floodlit, all-weather pitch also allows for play later into the evening. Therefore, it was decided to submit a NEUTRAL comment, with the request to review in six months to see how these changes impact users.
