# Why we're making changes to the Haverhill network

At Stagecoach East, we care about keeping local communities connected to the people and places that matter most. We regularly review our passenger numbers and the customer feedback we receive, so that we can continue to make improvements to our services.

Currently, there are low passenger numbers on the 131 and 131A routes within Haverhill and we recognise that the network in its current form can be a little confusing. We also understand that fast and direct journeys between Haverhill and Cambridge are important for the local community.

Following this analysis, we have designed a new network that will be introduced from Sunday 3rd March 2023. This will consist of three routes: 13, 13A and X13. All three of these routes will operate between Haverhill and Cambridge, and a full overview of the new network can be found below.

# Overview of the changes


**Routes 131/131a** to be removed and a new route **13a** will be introduced to serve Chimswell and Chivers, with departures every 60 minutes. There will be no dedicated Haverhill town service and instead all routes will operate between Haverhill and Cambridge.

**Route 13** will serve Arrendene at peak times only, so that we can reinvest resource into the X13. Those living in the Arrendene area will instead have a short walk to the bus stops on Withersfield Road where they can catch the X13, or Sainsbury's where they can catch the 13a.

**Route X13** to maintain the current route and have additional departures into Cambridge throughout the day, offering more fast and direct journeys. Some journeys will also serve Kedington.

Routes **13** and **13a** will together offer two departures an hour into Cambridge at peak times.


